Guest Policy

All guests must be accompanied by a Klahaya member when using the Club.

WHAT IS A GUEST?

- A guest is any non-member who sets foot on Klahaya property for activities, including but not limited to swimming, tennis, sunbathing, picnicking and basketball (see bylaws Article 2 for more detail). Members shall be held responsible for the actions of their guests and must be with their guests while they are using the Klahaya facility.
- Members will be asked to pay for each guest at the front desk when they arrive. Members can purchase guest passes in advance by using the member portal, or membership app
- Entrance to the Club costs \$5 per guest, each time they visit the club.
- Groups that include 5-9 guests must make a courtesy call to the pool prior to arriving to ensure there is adequate capacity. Groups of 10 or more should rent the pool (see Pool Rental tab).

NOTE: All guests are required to fill out a liability form prior to entering the club. Liability forms for anyone under 18 must be signed by their legal guardian prior to use of the club.

NANNY/CAREGIVER PASS

Nanny / Caregiver Pass - \$75

Each year you may add a Nanny/Caregiver guest pass through the member portal, app. The Membership director or manager will review and approve before your account is updated.

The fee is \$75 per person, per year. (*This is subject to change at the discretion of the board at time of annual budgeting.)

A few important things to note:

- Nannies/Caregivers are considered guests of yours and as such you are responsible for their acts and conduct. Members are required to pay all charges and liabilities incurred by their guests.
- Per the guest policy, caregivers will only be allowed entry when accompanied by a member (in this case a member's child/children under their care).
- At this time, the minimum age for a nanny or caregiver is set to 18 years old. If you have a nanny/caregiver younger than 18 you wish to add, please contact membership explaining the situation.
- At this time, the number of caregivers per account is limited to two (2); again, if you feel you need to add more than two caregivers, please contact membership explaining your situation.



- Nannies/Caregivers will check in at the front desk just as all members do, their photo will be verified, liability waiver confirmed and confirmation that they have member children with them under their care.

GUEST/CAREGIVER FAQs

Q: Are grandparents guests or caregivers?

A: The answer is up to each membership. If you think a grandparent will bring your kids to the club and supervise them more than 5 times per year, it might make more sense for you to list them as a caregiver. If you think they will come with the whole family a few times, then you might choose a guest.

Q: Grandparents, Au Pairs, and relatives live with us full time so are they members?

A: Yes, per the bylaws, all persons residing in your house are considered members. Live in additions such as grandparents, babysitters, Au Pairs, etc. can be added yearly as members but must provide Klahaya Membership (membership@klahaya.net) with a valid form of verification that they live in the home for example a drivers license, voter registration card, utility bill, etc.

Q: My grandkids/nieces/nephews/exchange students, etc. live at our house full time in the summer. Can I add them as members or can I register them for teams?

A: Per the Klahaya Bylaws AND the Greater Seattle Summer Swim League rules, a person who lives in the member home full time for 6 or more **consecutive** weeks can be considered a houseguest-member and/or register for swim team. We ask that you affirm their eligibility in writing. This needs to be done annually and houseguest-members are cleared from accounts at the end of each season. Q: How do I pay for guest passes?

A: You will be asked to pay by credit card or check at the front desk for your guests when you arrive. You can also pre-load guest script to your account on the Make a Payment page.

Q: Can my child bring a friend to the club without me?

A: Yes, provided the child meets the minimum age and supervision requirements and their legal guardian has completed a guest liability waiver on their behalf. Be sure to have guest script on your account or send payment with them.

Q: How do I add members to my account?

A: Contact membership and share why circumstances have changed. Membership will review and follow up with next steps.
